WILL SHUT HIM HEALY OUT THE SOUTH KERRY ELECTION HIS DOWNFALL

McCarthy's Denunciation of Him as a Traitor to the Nationalist Cause to Oust the Healyites From the Parliamentary Committee—Another Agitation to Destroy Atlantic Derelicts

London, Sept. 7.—The result of the election in the south division of Kerry was announced yesterday. It was a victory for the Healyites. It was a defeat for the McCarthyites, who naturally are jubilant over the success of their candidate, Mr. Farrell.

Mr. William O'Brien, who some time ago was compelled to retire from Parliament owing to his having been declared a bankrupt, took an active part in the campaign, speaking and working for Mr. Farrell. In one of his speeches to the electors, he said: "We have got to deal with Healy once for all, and we will do it, and he was cheered to the echo by his auditors. These words reflect with absolute fidelity the determination of the best men in the anti-Parrellite party, among whom, since Mr. McCarthy denounced Healy, as a traitor, the consensus of opinion is that the only chance to restore unity in the ranks lies in the expulsion of Healy.

The smash-up of his nominees in South Kerry, where the Healyite faction was supposed to be strong, having the clerical influence on their side, will be fertile with happy consequences. If the McCarthyite candidate had been defeated a schism that would have rent the party to pieces would have been inevitable.

Messrs. McCarthy, Sexton and William O'Brien meant, in such an event, to have immediately retired to private life, leaving the factions to fight the battle out. The election was a test of the feeling of the people, and it has occurred that so decisively to put down the Healyite revolt in the Irish Parliamentary party.

On the eve of the election the representative of the United Press attempted to obtain the views of Mr. John Dillon on the likely to be adopted by the existing majority of the Parliamentary Committee towards Mr. Healy. Mr. Dillon, in his wonted cautious, non-committal manner, simply expressed the conviction that the Irish party would come well out of the struggle.

The Healy question, he said, would certainly come before the committee, but as the record just commenced he could not say when. In regard to Mr. Healy's accusation that he (Dillon) inspired Mr. McCarthy's recent and recent, he could only say that he never noticed such imputations.

Since seeing Mr. Dillon, the representative of the United Press has learned that the leaders of the party consider favorably a proposition to hold the Nationalist convention in Dublin. They are confident that they will obtain the assent of the convention to the Nationalist Convention from the Parliamentary Committee.

T. F. O'Connor, in an extra edition of his paper, The Sun, says that far-reaching results will arise from the South Kerry election. The only regret is that Healy's resignation, wrecking the party was not earlier opposed, and that the too cautious patriotism of the Irish members prompted them to conciliatory tactics, when they might at the beginning have quelled the revolt.

Destroying Derelicts. The plan for destroying the dangerous derelicts in the navigation on the North Atlantic by the concerted action of the American and British navies has received a great impetus through the formal action of the Lloyd's Committee, which has at last awakened to the fact that an unfavorable report of the Royal Commission which investigated the subject was utterly fallacious.

The Monthly Pilot Charts have demonstrated that over 60 per cent of the worst floating dangers in the North Atlantic were nearer the British Islands than the entrance to the English Channel fairly teemed with abandoned hulks, many of them right in the track of trans-Atlantic passenger vessels, and the Lloyd's Association, with its enormous financial interest in the safety of ships insured through its agencies, became alarmed and determined to secure from the Salisbury Government what an unorganized marine interest had denied by the Rosebery commission.

Lloyd's has now presented the matter to the Board of Trade with great earnestness, and is confident of more tangible results. The Cabinet officer at the head of the Board of Trade is Hon. C. T. Ritchie, who was also in Lord Salisbury's last Cabinet in another position, and he is aware that the office over which he presided has

been afflicted with dry-rot for many years. Another influential gentleman, who has been aroused by the hydrographic office and Lloyd's, is J. C. MacDonna, a leading Conservative, having written a volume entitled, "Across the Andes."

Mr. MacDonna, has achieved somewhat of a reputation as the Hon. Mr. O'Brien's derelict expert, exciting warm discussions through his advocacy against the majority of the Commons and the Ministers of the American plan for clearing the seas of drifting dangers. Now, however, himself a member of the majority and harmonious with the majority leaders, he is confident that investigation of the subject will be had. It may be said that the probabilities are excellent that Parliament, upon recommendations of the board, will authorize the sending of one or more expeditions to Washington before the end of September to examine into the advisability of an international agreement for the destruction of derelicts and the best means of accomplishing this end, through the concerted action of the nations.

THE LABOR CONGRESS. Abolition of Lieut-Governors and an Alien Labor Law Desired. London, Sept. 7.—The concluding sessions of the Labor Congress were replete with spirited debates, and business was gotten through in a few days. The resolution of the United States, of which Commissioner Barry of Buffalo is a noted exponent, was adopted, which is the resolution of Michael Powell, Jr., of London, asking for a similar law in the United States.

Resolved that this Congress petition the Federal Government to pass an alien labor law which would prohibit foreign labor from being employed in holding positions, thereby depriving other workmen of their work, unless becoming Canadian citizens after residing in the country for not less than six months. It was adopted.

Abolish Lieut-Governors. There was no opposition to a motion of Delegate Darlington to abolish the office of Lieutenant-Governor of the different provinces. The resolution styled the position as being one "created for the purpose of giving a soft berth to party politicians at the expense of the community in general." Another motion of Mr. Darlington's, to allow no person a seat at the Congress who receives a salary from either the Federal or Provincial Governments, was defeated. The Government will be requested to place a label on all articles made in Canada, stating the fact that it is a product of the Dominion, and to allow no person a seat at the Congress who receives a salary from either the Federal or Provincial Governments, was defeated. All union men will be asked to pledge themselves not to accept any person at a seat at the Congress who interferes with organized labor.
