**Scientific and Useful.**

**CREAM CAKE WITHOUT EGGS.**—Four cups of flour, three cups of sugar, one cup of butter, two cups of sour cream, three teaspoonfuls of saleratus dissolved in a little water, half grated nutmeg, and a teaspoonful of essence of lemon.

**CHINESE SANDWICHES.**—Pound in a mortar two ounces of good cheese. Cut in very thin slices one ounce of fresh butter, a table-spoonful of cream and a little mixed mustard. Spread the mixture on slices of bread neatly cut, lay another slice of bread on each and press together; cut into corners or squares.

**BREAKFAST CAKES.**—Excellent breakfast cakes are made of three eggs, one teaspoonful of sugar, one coffee cup of sweet milk, one cup of warm water, three table-spoonful of yeast, flour enough to make a stiff batter. Leave the whites of the eggs until the batter has risen, then add them. A pinch of salt is needed. If started the night before, these cakes are delicious. They will be as light as puffs.

**MACARONI AND KIDNEYS.**—Cook two ounces of macaroni in boiling water; skin three mutton or ox kidneys and remove the fat, cut them into slices, season with salt, cayenne, and finely mixed herbs; fry them on both sides with butter; then stir in half a pint of gravy well flavoured with tomatoes. Dish with a layer of macaroni over them, the gravy poured over; add pepper, salt, and chopped hard boiled eggs and some grated Parmesan cheese.

**BREAD PUDDING FOR CHILDREN.**—In making bread pudding for children take two slices of bread (or any odd pieces, if clean), crumble them into a goblet (an enamelled one if you have it), add a handful of sultana raisins, cover with milk, boil, and set aside to simmer very slowly for twenty minutes. Then add one egg, a small bit of butter, sugar to taste, a little grated nutmeg, lemon, or other seasoning; mix thoroughly, turn into a pudding dish, and brown in the oven.

**BREAD MOULD (A GERMAN DISH).**—Stir well together the yolks of six eggs and three ounces of powdered sugar, mix in two ounces of grated bread, any approved flavouring of spice or grated lemon peel, and the whites of four eggs whisked to a swift snow stirred lightly in at last; have a mould well buttered, sprinkle in it some finely-shred blanched almonds, and lay here and there a thin slice of candied peel. Put the mass into the mould and steam it with care. Boil sugar to a thread height and pour it over when the koch is turned out of the mould. Serve it without delay.

**HOUSEKEEPER'S WEIGHTS AND MEASURES.**—Two gills make a half pint. Two pints make one quart. Four quarts make one gallon. Half a gallon is a quarter of a peck. Two gallons make one peck. Four gallons make half a bushel. Eight gallons make one bushel. About sixty drops of any thin liquid will fill a common sized teaspoon. Four table-spoonfuls, or one half a gill, will fill a common-sized wineglass. Four wineglass-fuls will fill a half pint measure, a common tumbler, or a large coffee cup. Ten eggs usually weigh one pound before they are broken. A table-spoonful of salt weighs one ounce.

**POTTED MEAT (BEEF).**—Take one pound and a quarter of rump steak free from skin and sinew; put into a stewpan with half a pound of good butter, place on the stove or in the oven, and let it stew for one hour. Take it out of the stewpan, and put it in a mortar and pound till quite smooth; add sufficient of the butter (that it was stewed in will do) by degrees to make the whole into a soft paste, then add a little salt, white pepper, cayenne, and mace to taste. Add a little bol-armenia to give it a red tint. Rub through a sieve, or tammy, and put in pots, and pour over some melted lard or butter, and cover with vegetable parchment, pasted down on the pots to keep the potted meat air-tight.
