He often asked himself what fatuous policy blinded so great and intelligent a nation as England, in the present of Ireland. What is his blindness to ignore that the 40,000 young men who had gone to the United States from Ireland in the last ten years had left their country with a feeling of vengeance against England? Every day public opinion in the United States is becoming more a matter for anxiety in Great Britain. The Irish in America are not only the best of the best of the people of the Ancient Order of Hibernians in the United States would take up arms against England; you could not find an Irishman in Canada who would not because here in Canada we have reason to be deeply grateful for what England has done for us (applause).
