As you may know, the Deaver trial is now scheduled to commence on October 19, 1987. As you undoubtedly realize, the decision of the Government of Canada not to permit even limited testimony by Ambassador Gottlieb has forced us to place much greater emphasis at trial on the unlawful acts engaged in by Deaver when he was working for the Canadian Government, including his various contacts with Drew Lewis and the River Club meeting on October 25, 1985, in which Mr. Gottlieb and Mr. Doucet participated.

If you see any sign that your client might allow Mr. Gottlieb to give limited testimony confirming the January 5 luncheon, making it unnecessary for us to emphasize these other events, please get in touch with us promptly.
