

On motion of Mr. Howard, seconded by Mr. Knowles, it was ordered,—That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency praying that he will cause to be laid before this House a copy of the agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Province of British Columbia and any amendments thereto relating to the construction of the Stewart-Cassiar Road.—(*Notice of Motion for the Production of Papers No. 159*).
