

of railway line north and east of a line described as commencing at the southeast corner of the township of Huron and running west to the southwest corner of the township of Huron and north to the north boundary of the said district.

TORONTO EAST consisting of that part of the city of Toronto bounded by a line described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the northern boundary of the said city with Page Avenue and following Page Avenue, thence easterly to the intersection of the said Page Avenue and the projection easterly of Huron Street to Lake Ontario, thence continuing along the shore of the said Lake Ontario through the eastern channel and Toronto Harbour to the Don River and following the Don River up to the Flooded Valley Road thence following the line of the Canadian National Railway from west of the Don River to the northern boundary of the city and the said northern boundary to the place of commencement.

TORONTO EAST CENTRAL consisting of that part of the city of Toronto bounded on the north by Huron Street, on the south by the Don River and Toronto Harbour, on the east by the Don River and the line of the Canadian National Railway to the west limit and on the west by a line commencing at the intersection of Huron Street and Avenue Road and thence following Avenue Road, Queen's Park, Gerrard, University Avenue, Dundas Street, Jarvis Street and the projection southerly of Jarvis Street to Toronto Harbour.

TORONTO NORTHEAST consisting of that part of the city of Toronto bounded by a line described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of Huron Street with the line of the Canadian National Railway from west of the Don River, thence following Huron Street and Harbour Street to the north boundary of the city and thence following the city limits easterly, northerly and southerly, and the said line of railway southerly to the point of commencement.

TORONTO NORTHWEST consisting of that part of the city of Toronto bounded on the south by Huron Street, on the east by Harbour Street, on the north by the city limits, and on the west by a line commencing at the intersection of the said limits with the line of the Northern Division of the Canadian National Railway, thence following the said line of railway, the said line of the Canadian Pacific Railway easterly and Lakeshore Avenue southerly to Huron Street.

TORONTO SCARBOROUGH consisting of that part of the city of Toronto from east of a line described as commencing at the intersection of Page Avenue with the
