

The Committee further agrees that the subscription
of members to the services of the experts, committee
or subcommittee shall be kept to a minimum.

A proposal of the Standing Committee
of the Senate to the effect that the services of
any three of the four specialists be retained
by the Senate is counteracted by the fact that
the Senate has no funds available for such
a purpose. It is therefore recommended that
the Senate accept the services of the four
experts for the period from April 1, 1970, to
April 1, 1971, at a total cost of \$10,000.
The Standing Committee further recommends
that the Senate be authorized to receive
evidence from the printing branch of
the Canadian Government on the
subject of the proposed legislation.

Your Committee also recommends that
the amount of compensation of the experts
be limited to \$2,000 per month as the
Senate has no funds available.

Our Standing Committee will be responsible to the Standing
Committee of the Senate for the services of the
four specialists. It is the
recommendation of your Committee that the
Senate be authorized to retain the services of the
four specialists until the end of the session of
the Senate. It is also recommended that the
Senate be authorized to receive evidence
from the printing branch of the Canadian
Government on the proposed legislation.
