#### Question No. 463-Mr. Rheaume:

1. What were the capital expenditures in connection with the operation and maintenance of the Mackenzie highway system in each fiscal year since 1958-59, under each of the following headings (a) machinery including staff vehicles, parts tools and equipment (b) buildings, including workshops, warehouses, garages?

2. What has been the total annual operating  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{costs}}$  of all vehicles, machinery equipment and buildings (other than staff housing) for each year since 1958-59, under the following headings (a) parts and repairs to equipment, vehicle, machinery (b) heat, light, power, water and maintenance to buildings?

3. What is the estimated depreciated value of all buildings materials and equipment now in use on the Mackenzie highway system?
