Question No. 1,794—Mr. Orlikow:

1. For the fiscal year 1976-77, what contracts for professional services were let for studies, surveys and analyses into (a) present or future policies, programmes or information analysis and their efficiency and effectiveness (b) the examination of the administration or internal operation of the Department of Communications?

2. How much was committed on each contract and to whom?

Mr. C. Douglas (Parliamentary Secretary to Minister of Communications): As far as the Department of Communications is concerned, the answer to the above question is as follows: 1. The list of professional services contracts let for studies, surveys and analyses into (a) present or future policies, programmes or information analysis and their efficiency and effectiveness (b) the examination of the administration or internal operation of the Department of Communications for the fiscal year 1976-77 is attached:

(a) For the fiscal year 1976-77 the following contracts were let for studies, surveys and analyses: Study of the independent

program production industry with respect to English language programs for broadcast in Canada. Study to evaluate structural models of proposed pay television service. Study to develop a regional reporting system identifying and documenting work processes and developing performance (output) indicators. Study relating to evaluation of the Department of Communications low power FM broadcasting standard. Study on marketability and policy impact of closed circuit programming with videodiscs and videocassettes in Canada. Study of standard issues for access protocols of public networks. Study relative to future financial needs in the telecommunications sector.

(b) Contracts for the examination of the administration or internal operation of the Department of Communications are: Internal review audit services. Financial organization study. Financial systems development. Government Telecommunications Agency (GTA) Financial organization study.
