The following resolution was adopted:

Resolved,—That it is expedient to introduce a measure to amend the Emergency Gold Mining Assistance Act to extend its application to the years 1959 and 1960 and to provide for a twenty-five per cent increase in the amount of assistance for the years 1958, 1959 and 1960.

Mr. Comtois, seconded by Mr. Green, by leave of the House, presented a Bill, No. C-53, An Act to amend the Emergency Gold Mining Assistance Act, which was read the first time.

By unanimous consent, the said Bill was read the second time, considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, and ordered for a third reading at the next sitting of the House.

The said resolution was reported and concurred in.

Mr. Comtois, seconded by Mr. Nowlan, by leave of the House, presented a Bill, No. C-54, An Act to authorize certain Amendments to the Agreement made under the Maritime Coal Production Assistance Act with The Dominion Coal Company, Limited, which was read the first time.

By unanimous consent, the said Bill was read the second time, considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, read the third time and passed.

The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole to consider a certain proposed resolution to establish a Board of Broadcast Governors, and progress having been made and reported, the Committee obtained leave to consider it again at the next sitting of the House.
