2. If any proof is found by the Committee Defective to be defective, it may be supplemented by proof. statutory declaration to be laid before the Committee.

3. If the circumstances of the case seem Substiso to require, the Committee, before proceed-service. ing to hearing and inquiry as hereinafter required, may make such order as to the Committee seems requisite and just for effecting substitutional service by advertisement, registered letter, or otherwise, upon both or either of the parties.

4. If the requirements of these rules, or of Non-comany order made thereunder by the Com-pliance with rules, etc. mittee, have not been complied with in any material respect, the Committee shall report thereon to the Senate, and shall not, without further order from the Senate, proceed to hear and inquire into the matters set forth in the petition.
