WITH regard to the strange Idea of the proposed Guaranty of *Spain*, mentioned in Mr. *Stanley's* Dispatches, as also with respect to the Engagements with *Spain*, concerning our Disputes with that Crown, which the Duc de Choiseul now avows to have been taken before the first Overtures of *France*, for the particular Peace with *England*, and which consequently had been from that Time as disingenuously suppressed, as they were in the Moment
