Now, therefore, know ye, that I, the Governor, by the advice of Her Majesty's Executive Council, do hereby issue this Proclamation, and I do hereby request and desire all Her Majesty's loving subjects in this Province to discover, and to apprehend the said Louis Joseph Papineau wherever he may be found there, and to bring him before such Justice assigned to receive him, and to deliver him up to the said Justice assigned to keep the Peace or Chief Magistrate for Montreal aforesaid; and for the encouragement of all persons so endeavouring to discover and apprehend the said Louis Joseph Papineau, I do hereby offer a Reward of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS of the money of this Province, to whomsoever shall so apprehend the said Louis Joseph Papineau and deliver him up to Justice.
