

CIVIC HOSPITAL NEEDED

Residents of Ward Seven Will Apply to Board of Control for More Accommodation.

Fraternal societies and labor organizations are going to approach the board of control in the near future to urge that Toronto establish a civic hospital. There is no part of a hospital than the ward end and the fact of its being a railroad centre, where accidents are a daily occurrence, makes it doubly urgent that the natural condition be suitably equipped for such a hospital and many excellent sites exist in various parts of Ward Seven from which one might be chosen.

In the past the matter has been well discussed in the old town council, and of late the board of control has been discussing the matter in a well-considered manner. It is manifestly a very limited. Such a hospital as is proposed, however, will serve all the western district of Toronto.

Italian Flotilla Escaped Unharm

Retreated Following Dash Into Dardanelles After Finding Turkish Warships Were Protected.

ROME, July 20. (Can. Press.)—An official communication regarding the Dardanelles affair says that a flotilla of torpedo boats "while perhaps pursuing the enemy's torpedo boats, or for the purpose of reconnoitering," made a dash into the Dardanelles. Although detected by searchlights and fired on by the forts on each shore, they pulled out on the heavy fire of the forts, reaching the Aegean intact, thanks to the enemy's bad gunnery.
