ONTARIO'S TURN ROW.

Ontario is the dominant factor in the Con-

servative party to-day, and Ontario Con-

servatives must henceforth assert them-

selves. The policy of the Conservative

party must, for a time at least, be largely

shaped by them. Since Sir John Macdonald

died the policy of the party was made much

of outside of Ontario, and some of it was

dictated by the anti-French feeling of the

party in this province. Ontario Conserva-

tives owe it to themselves to get together,

to size up the situation, to blaze out a

new and straight road, and then to go

forward. The Legislature of Ontario must

be regenerated and the Ross Government

sent to the crematorium. But only a caucus

of all the Conservatives of Ontario will

effect this end, and start the ball rolling in

the right direction.

THE ELECTION AND ITS LESSONS.

Sir Wilfrid Laurier's majority of 57,000

in Quebec is the greatest factor in the

new Parliament. This force, championed

by Mr. Tarte, is the only one in the

country in its hands. There is only one

by which this force can be successfully

restated, and that is by the formation of a

coalition Government. It is not war-

ranting a course of the present time,

although no one can foresee what may hap-

pen in the future. Until the crisis becomes

more active, however, Canada will be gov-

erned by Mr. Tarte and his following. The

situation has no parallel in our history

since Confederation. During the Conserva-

tive regime Sir John Macdonald and his

successors stood between the English and

French-speaking people of Canada. The

French-Canadians have ranged themselves

more or less as a unit, and along, almost

never to such an extent as at present, but

Sir John Macdonald was always able to

hold them in check and prevent them from

unleashing power which did not rightly be-

long to them. Hon. Alexander Macdonald

occupied a similar defensive position

against the incursions of the French.

He kept the treasury well guarded and

was able to keep the Quebec movement

in place. Nor did they ever get the

upper hand under Sir John Thompson or

Sir Mackenzie Bowden. Quite different is

the situation to-day. What is the conse-

quence? It is that the Liberal Govern-

ment to protect the country against the

aggressiveness of Quebec? Not a soul.

Not an English-speaking member with any

authority behind him. What is the conse-
