WHO SHOULD PAY FOR IT? Bundas-St. Bridge Matter Again Be-


fore Court of Revision.

A large deputation of legal gentlemen waited on the Court of Revision vesterday afternoon in connection with the assessment for the Dundas-street bridges. The matter has been hanging fire for about 13 years. It was recommended by the City Engineer in 1889 that the bridges be built on a fully signed petition by interested ratepayers and that a portion of the cost be ers and that a portion of the cost be charged against a certain section west of the bridges. Owing to irregularities the procedure was made null and void by a judgment of County Judge McDougall in 1900. The reason for the delay was owing to extensive litigation and arbitrations in connection with the land damages, which was to be the ratepayers' proportion of the cost, and until they were finally settled an assessment could not be made. be the ratepayers' proportion of the cost, and until they were finally settled an assessment could not be made. When the matter came before the Court of Revision yesterday, it was held by the ratepayers interested that the procedure was still irregular. The matter now rests with the Court of Revision to decide as to whether they have jurisdiction to act at all.

The point of the whole matter is whether or not the city should pay for the whole cost of the bridge and land damages, which it appears was never contemplated in the original petition and the Engineer's report of 1889, and even in 1900 the Court of Revision fixed the amount to be paid by the ratepayers at \$25,000.

The total cost of the bridge was something more than \$150,000, and the ratepayers affected are wanted to pay about \$68,000 of it. The city has already paid \$30,000, the C.P.R. has paid \$9000 and the G.T.R. \$11,000.


