

## ASK RAILWAY BOARD TO CONSIDER SUBWAY AT RECTORY STREET

Special Committee of Council  
Discusses Methods of Re-  
ducing Danger From Rail-  
way Crossings—Additional  
Lights To Be Placed.

Immediate appeal to the Railway Board to consider the building of a subway at Rectory street, and possibly other points on the G. T. R. system in the city was recommended by a special committee of the city council last night. The committee, consisting of Ald. Cameron Wilson, C. G. Moorehead, F. R. Watkinson and G. H. Drake, was appointed to review the whole situation in regard to level crossings. Ald. Wilson, who was instrumental in having the committee appointed, was elected chairman. The board will be asked to send a representative here to investigate conditions.

Other steps taken by the committee were to recommend additional lights at the crossings; have the city engineer report on the crossing at Rectory street with a view of having the approach of crossings; to ask the railway board to consider the protection of the crossings; twenty-four hours a day, instead of twelve as at present, and to see that young men are appointed as crossing watchmen.

City Engineer Brainer said that additional lights had been placed on some of the crossings last year, and that provision for the crossing at Rectory street was made for 50 more lights in these crossings. 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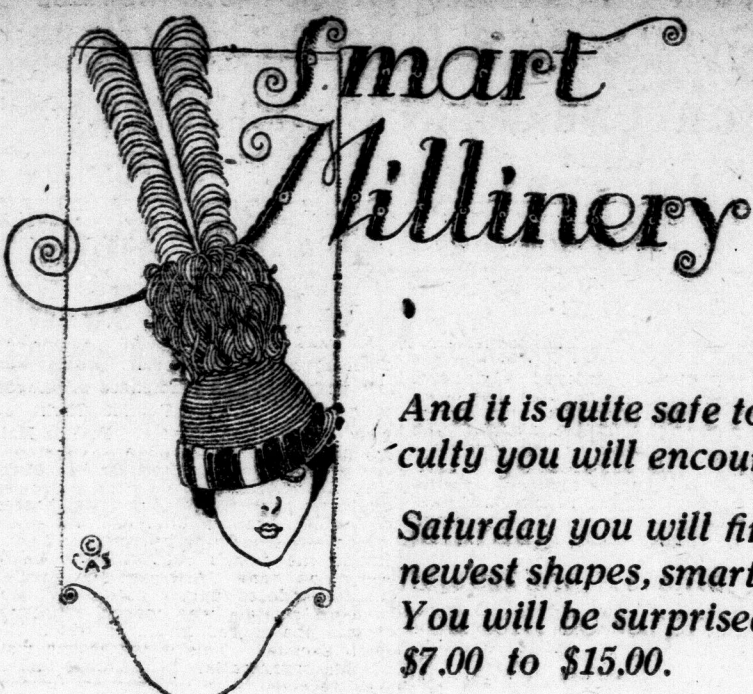
