the best taught and best conducted under the patronage of the Board. There has been quite an increase during the past year; the numbers for the last quarter being thirty six. The Rev. the Rector for Kingston reports, "Of the forty two pupils entered on the list of the School during the last quarter, I found thirty three in attendance when I made a casual visit and examined them on the 16th of this month (May). Their general intelligence, evident interest in the studies and consequent progress continue to afford a most satisfactory evidence that the master is both 'apt to teach and most diligent in teaching.""
