

ANNUAL MEETING OF GOVERNORS.

The Annual Meeting of the Governors of the Montreal General Hospital was held on Thursday, 18th May, 1893.

The President, Mr. John Stirling, occupied the chair.

The Chairman appointed Messrs. W. M. Ramsay, W. A. Molson, M.D., and W. E. Cheese to act as Scrutineers. The meeting then proceeded to elect Officers for the year. On completion of the ballots, and announcement made of the results of the election, the following resolutions were severally submitted with appropriate remarks and unanimously passed :—

MR. THOS. DAVIDSON moved to the effect that as Dr. Roddick had resigned as attending surgeon, he be placed on the consulting staff.

This was seconded by Mr. R. P. McLEA, and unanimously agreed to.

MR. CHARLES ALEXANDER spoke in laudatory terms of Mr. John Stirling's connection with the Hospital, and moved the following :

"That the thanks of this Corporation be and are hereby heartily tendered to Mr. John Stirling, who has for many years rendered faithful service to the Institution, having for some fourteen years been on the Committee of Management, and for the last four years acted as President. Mr. Stirling now voluntarily retires, bearing with him the best wishes of the Corporation, with the hope that he will ever continue the firm friend of the Hospital that he has been in the past."

MR. THOS. DAVIDSON seconded the motion, bearing testimony to Mr. Stirling's services, and it was carried unanimously.

MR. STIRLING thanked the meeting for its kindness, and promised that, as in the past, he would ever do his duty as far as he could towards the furtherance of the interests of the Hospital.

D. C. MACCALLUM, M.D., moved, seconded by MR. J. CRAWFORD :

"That the thanks of the Governors are due and are by this resolution tendered to the Committee of Management, for their administration of the affairs of the Hospital during the past year."

MR. C. P. HEBERT moved, seconded by MR. JOHN KERRY :

"That the valuable services of the Medical Board during the past year deserve the thanks of the Governors, which are by this resolution presented to them."

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
