WHITE NIGHTS.

How St. Petersburg Spends Its Summer - By Robert Crozier

ST. PETERSBURG, July 26 - It is midnight and at the same time daylight. Barely two hours ago the sun disappeared in a haze of revolutionary flames, and these flames will burn above the northern pine hills, without a moment's darkness, they blend insensibly into a revolutionary dawn. People sit in the open air reading books. They can read uninterupted for thirty days without artificial light. Living in a line with Alaska, as far north of New York as New York is of Cuba, they forget for a month the impending dissolution of their empire, and surrender themselves to the enchantments of the White Nights. Neither bombs nor "pogroms" have stopped the nation's nocturnal life.

The White Nights are St. Petersburg's own natural charm. So with the coming of summer the city is some "dacha," some garden in Finland, or on the islands in the delta of the Neva-armed Neva.

"Dachas" make summer life - as swallows elsewhere. Built in sunlit birch forests, they are unattended through eight or ten months, after which they are invaded in a rash by tired Petersburgers and unwearying insects that fill the end of August with an insupportable war.

Every one admits that "dacha" life is torture. The house is cold, damp, infamously equipped for the summer. But one migrates. You can hire a "dacha" for the whole summer for fifty dollars or more, and according to the amount of space and water, and in return you supply the table with summer produce - "dacha" products, which are sold through miles of middlemen, but with a little and military; the "dacha" maid, or summer
