TAFT FAVORS A TARIFF REVISION

Roosevelt to Wage War on the Old Guard of the Republican Party in New York

Boston, Aug. 24.—President Taft's keynote for the coming congressional campaign became known at Beverly last night. The president will favor a further revision of the tariff. While he is still convinced that the Payne-Aldrich law is the best tariff act the country has had up to this time, he has at last reached the conclusion that there is decided room for improvement.

Mr. Taft does not suppose that business shall be upset by another wholesale revision, but he will recommend to congress that individual schedules in the tariff system be taken up separately and be disposed of on a scientific basis. The new revision is to be based upon findings of the tariff commission as to the cost of production at home and abroad. Only a fair profit is to be allowed the American producer. Exorbitant and unreasonable profits, the president declares, are to be tolerated no longer.

Political observers regard this move as about the shrewdest that has been made during the present administration. It offers an excellent opportunity for the insurgents and regulars to get together in the campaign, and President Taft has been exceedingly anxious to find a ground upon which the different factions could meet without embarrassment to either.

Utica, N. Y., Aug. 24.—Theodore Roosevelt severed notice today that he would wage war without quarter on the "old guard" of the Republican party in New York state.

"They will have all the fight they want," replied Mr. Roosevelt. "If an only going to the convention because I feel that the public interests, the interests of the people of New York demand that the Republican party be given a chance to stand squarely and uncompromisingly for clean government."

"I go to that convention to make the speech exactly as it has been originally planned and while I hope there will be enough good sense to prevent any opposing the principles for which I shall stand yet if they do oppose them then it is their own affair and so far as I am concerned the issue shall be absolutely clear."
