GOVERNMENT SUES OWNER OF WRECKED P. E. ISLAND SCHOONER

Charlottetown, P. E. I., Jan. 27.—J. D. McDonald of Charlottetown, owner of the schooner Barbara A. McDonald, smashed to pieces on the Newfoundland Coast about two years ago when the crew had a miraculous escape, is being sued by the Dominion Government for the amount paid to the Newfoundland Government for clothing and food supplied the shipwrecked crew.

LOWERING OF RATES ON FERTILIZERS

After the meetings of the Dominion board of railway commissioners in Halifax and St. John, there was a conference held between representatives of the railways and the farmers about the rates on fertilizers. C. M. Hayes represented the C. N. R., W. H. Macdonnell the C. P. R., and A. H. Margeson and H. B. Durst the farmers. The railway men thought that it would be impossible to effect a general lowering of fertilizer rates, but suggested several concessions which brought the rates of some of the high price ones more nearly equal to the others and made rates to different parts of the province more equal.

TO MAKE RATS ILLEGAL

Hamilton, Ont., Jan. 27.—The local Board of Health will recommend to the provincial health authorities the enactment of new legislation which will make it a breach of the Public Health Act for anyone to maintain rats or vermin in premises.
