APPENDIX.

2. On Theological Education.—Messrs. Topp, Kemp, Laing, Ross, McMurrich. Mr. Topp, Convener.
3. On Act securing congregations in possession of their property.—Messrs. Kemp, Gregg, Reid, McMurrich, and F. Torrance. Mr. Kemp, Convener.
4. On Forms of Ecclesiastical Processes.—Messrs. Gillespie, Kemp, and Gregg. Mr. Gillespie, Convener (Princeton P. O.)
5. On Widows' Fund.—The existing Committee on Widows' Fund is appointed to confer with Committee of United Presbyterian Church. James Osborne, Esq., Hamilton, Convener. Rev. W. Reid, Toronto, Secretary.
6. Committee on arrangements for consummation of Union.—Presbytery of Montreal, with elders resident in the city, together with Moderator and Clerk of Synod, and Messrs. Ure, Scott, Dr. Irvine, Messrs. Laing, McLaren, J. K. Smith, and Duncan. Mr. Kemp, as Clerk of Presbytery of Montreal, will act as Convener.
