SYNOPSIS OF **Canadian North-West**

Homestoad Regulations.

Any even numbered section of Domi-nion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan snd Alberta, excepting 8 and 26, not re-aerved, may be homesteaded by any per-son who is the sole head of a family, cr any male over 18 years of age, to the ex-tent of one source results and age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 160, acres, more or less.

Entry must be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land is situate.

The homesteader is required to perform

the conditions connected therewith under one of the following plans : the ist (1) At least six months' residence up-on and cultivation of the land in each

year for three years.

 (2) If the father, (or mother, if the father is deceased) of the homesteader resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by such person residing with the father or mother.
 (3) If the satisfies her his (3) If the settler has his permanent

residence upon 'farming land owned by, him in the vicinity of his homestend, the requirements as to residence may be satis-fied by residence upon the said land.

Six months' notice in writing should. be given to the Comuissioner of Domini-on Lands at Ottawa of intenties to apply for patient. W. W. CORY.
