THE SYNOD OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CRURCH OF NOVA-Scoria met, after a Sermon by the Rev. Peren G. Mc-Gregor, the Moderator, from Ps. CXXII. 1. Peace be within thy walls, and prosperity within thy palaces," and was constituted.
