Madrid, Oct. 8.—Operations by the Spanish forces against hostile tribes in Morocco have been resumed, according to official despatches from Mellila. Covered by the fire of warships, two columns yesterday advanced 10 miles inland in the Kert Piver region, burning many houses and driving the tribesmen from their positions in spite of determined resistance. The engagement larked 10 hours and was directed by the minister of war, Gen. De Luque, in person. Details of the Spanish losses have not yet been received, but they are believed to have been heavy, exceeding 109. Col. Private operations continue today.
