THE BOUCHER PAPERS

MAY REVEAL FEW

MYSTERIES

These Papers Were Stolen by
the Germans in 1870 and
There is Much Speculation
as to the Nature of the Doc-
uments.

Paris, May 9.—The claims in the
peace treaty calling upon Germany to
return to France papers taken in 1870,
belonging to Eugene Boucher, a prom-
inent French statesman under the em-
pire, has caused much speculation as
to the nature of the documents. Bouch-
er, who was minister of justice when
the Franco-Prussian war broke out,
had secured a great number of private
and official documents in his
chateau. These were seized and car-
ried away by the Germans when they
invaded France and were never re-
stored.

The treaty does not say to what
questions the official papers relate but
it is recalled that Boucher was vio-
lently opposed to Thiers in 1867 on
the questions of German unity and
Italian unity as well as on the ques-
tion of conducting the property of
the Orleans family.

Boucher was a refugee in London
during the Franco-Prussian war and
was among the followers of former
Empress Eugenie. He returned to
France in 1871 but Thiers had him
conducted to the frontier. Afterward
he became a member of the chamber
of deputies and was active in attempt-
ing to reorganize the Bonapartist party.
