

three years of attendance upon medical studies shall be eligible for the intermediate examination, and must thereafter comply with the requirements for the fifth or final year, which is to be devoted to clinical work.

3. Application for every professional examination must be made to the Registrar of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario two weeks prior to examination. No application will be received unless it is accompanied by the necessary tickets and certificates, and by the Treasurer's receipt showing that the fees have been paid.

4. Excepting as hereinafter specified, each six or eight months' course shall consist of not less than fifty lectures, and "each three or four months' course," of not less than twenty-five lectures.

5. Every student must attend the undermentioned courses of lectures in a university, college, or school of medicine approved of by the Council, viz.:
