"Aliens," which by the first section of this Act is repealed.

XV. And be it enacted, That any per-False oath or son who shall wilfully swear falsely, or make affirmation to be perjury. 5 any false affirmation under the authority of this Act, before any Justice of the Peace or before any person having ex officio the power and authority of Justice of the Peace as aforesaid, shall be deemed guilty of wilful 10 and corrupt perjury, and every such person Forfeiture of shall, on conviction thereof, in addition to rights acquirany other punishment authorized by law, forfeit all the privileges and advantages which he would otherwise, by making such 15 oath or affirmation, have been entitled to under this Act; but the rights of others in Saving those respect to estates derived from or held under of innocent third parties. him shall not thereby be prejudiced, excepting always such others as shall have been 20 cognizant of the perjury at the time the title by which they claim to hold under him was

created.

XVI. And be it enacted, That every word Interpretation in this Act importing the masculine gender clause. 25 shall, when necessary, extend and be applied to a female as well as a male.

XVII. And be it enacted, That this Act This Act may may be amended, altered or repealed by any be amended Act to be passed in the present Session of 30 the Provincial Parliament.
