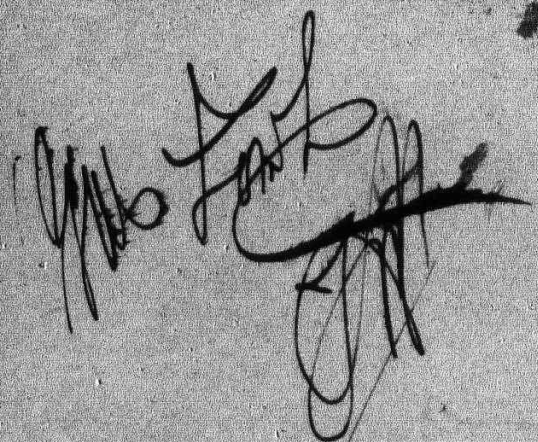


Ottawa, February 15th., 1919.
