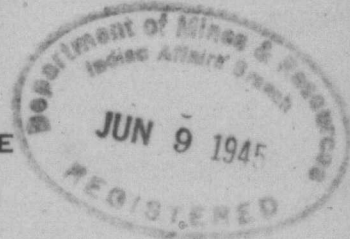

Treaty Payments - Churchill, Manitoba -  
1945.

1. I attach hereto a copy of a report received from Sergeant R. Stafford dated at Churchill, Manitoba, May 25th, 1945, in which he asks that \$1100.00 be sent to him for the above-mentioned purpose.
2. By now, he will have received a copy of your letter of May 17th, your file 3-138, and therefore his request for Treaty money has already been attended to by your Department.
3. This leaves the question of his transportation by Canadian Pacific Air Lines from Churchill to Duck Lake, and it will therefore be appreciated if you will attend to that particular matter, and let me know in due course what arrangements have been made.
