



Ottawa, 25th August, 1914.

Sir,-

I have to request that you will kindly forward  
to Dr. Armand Beausejour, at North Temiscamingue, <sup>P.Q.</sup> two hundred  
freshly charged vaccine points for use in vaccinating Indians.  
The doctor will require the points about the 1st September  
and therefore they should reach him by that date. Your account  
for the vaccine should be sent to the doctor, as his  
certificate thereto is required before the matter of payment  
can be dealt with.
