Madam,-

In further reference to your letter of the 12th instant applying for the position as teacher in the Carleton Place (R.C.) Indian Day School, I beg to say that the Department has today received the resignation of Miss K. Leahy, the principal, and will, therefore, be very pleased to accept your services for this position, to begin duties upon the opening of the school after the summer holidays, on or about the first of September, next. The salary allowed will be at the rate of \$700.00 per annum, together with the bonus at the rate of \$150.00 per annum during the present fiscal year.

As you have already taught at this school it will be unnecessary to give you any particulars regarding the accommodation, etc., provided.

I shall be pleased if you will reply immediately stating whether you will accept the above offer and, if so, if you will be prepared to begin duties by the first of September, next.
