have had a letter from my wife stating
she is in court for being married
again since I came overseas.
Like all that against me I was
depressed and I went off. I have
not drawn a pay since I came to
HMS Hermes - at least I have drawn
two ten shilling notes since ~~the~~
February 1941. This was because
I was paying the debts in which my
wife had involved me. I am 22 years
old and have been married since
September 1937. One of my children will
be four months and the other is three
years old. I have an assignment of
£2 a month which goes to John Smith at
Imbert. I have received pay as before
since I came over here. I was at
Blueshot during my absence and was
staying with a married couple there.
I was painting their house inside
while I was there & they gave me my
keep in exchange.
