a) Isolated Unserved Areas: \$1,272,000

\$175,000 will be required in 1971/72 to complete Frontier Coverage Package installations at Rainbow Lake, Alta.; Faro, Y.T.; and Falher, Alta.; and \$240,000 in 1971/72 to commence construction of English F.C.P. stations at Stewart, B.C.; Gagnon and Douglastown, P.Q.,; Fort Simpson, Frobisher Bay, Norman Wells and Tungsten, N.W.T.; Mayo and Ross River, Y.T.; and a French F.C.P. at Gagnon, P.Q. \$762,000 will be required in 1972/73 and \$95,000 in 1973/74 to complete Frontier Coverage installations started in 1971/72 and 1972/73.

b) Other Unserved Areas: \$20,044,000

\$3,040,000 will be required in 1971/72 and 1972/73 to complete construction of transmitters to provide English service to unserved areas. \$2,104,000 will be required in 1971/72 and 1972/73 to complete construction of facilities to extend French service to unserved areas. A further \$4,679,000 will be required in the fiscal years 1971/72 - 1974/75 to complete projects started in 1971/72 and 1972/73 to extend English service, and \$3,221,000 will be required in the fiscal years 1971/72 - 1974/75 to complete projects started in 1971/72 and 1972/73 to extend French service. A further \$1,000,000 (\$3,000,000 in 1973/74, \$4,000,000 in 1974/75) has been provided to continue improvements to coverage in both languages for stations now on the planning list for unserved and isolated areas.

c) Improvement to Coverage - Present Stations: \$315,000

\$190,000 will be required in 1971/72 and \$125.000 in 1972/73 to complete relocation of CBLT - Toronto transmitter, increase power at CBHT-1, Liverpool, N.S., and change the channel at CBFCT-1 Magadlen Islands, P.Q.

d) Alternative Service Development: \$1,225,000

\$1,225,000 required to complete construction at Antigonish, Inverness, Sydney and Truro, N.S.

e) Satellite Development: \$7,500,000

Present planning calls for the construction of the ground system to start in 1971/72 and be operational in 1972/73. The requirement of \$7,500,000 is broken down as 1971/72 - (\$3,800,000), 1972/73 - (\$3,000,000), 1973/74 - (\$400,000) and 1974/75 - (\$3,000,000).

2. Radio: \$5,053,000

a) Isolated Areas: \$875,000

A provision of \$875,000 has been included for the forecast period 1971/72 - 1974/75 to provide for English and French service to isolated areas which can be served by Low Power Relay Transmitters carrying either English or French network programs.

b) Other Unserved Areas: \$1,178,000

\$118,000 to continue with extension of French service in Saskatchewan, and \$120,000 to provide French service to Brockville, Ont. in 1973/74. \$940,000 has been provided in 1973/74 (\$475,000) and 1974/75 (\$465,000) to complete present English and French coverage plans.
