The Senate of St. Andrew's Univesity has decided to confer the degree of D.D. upon Rev. James Aitken, M.A. of Rychill Church, Dundee. Mr. Aitken recently declined a call from Muswell Hill Church, London.

An unusual incident occured recently in Uddingston Parish Church The preacher was in the middle of a sermon on the war when a lady suddenly rose up, and declaring that it was "War, war every Sunday," marched out of the church, shutting the door with a slam.

Dr. John Watson (Ian Maclaren', who will be moderator of the Presbyterian Synod which meets two months hence in Manchester, has just completed twenty-five years of ministerial life. After labouring in Scotland he became minister of Sefton Park Church, Liverpool, in **189**).

Rev. J.B. Meharry, while on the voyage to Anstralia, wrote to his congregation at Crouch Hill, London. Ile had been warned against overwork when reaching the Antipodes, Sydney, it was said, had killed Drs. Hannag and Berry. He was surprised to find a great many Presbyterians on board the steamer, and regarded it as strange that while arrangements are made for the Episcopalian services amongst first-class presengers no simular privilege was allowed noncomformists.
