CAP. VIII.

An ACT to provide for the supports of a Lighten House to be build upon Point Escuminacy in other County of Northumberland:

Passed the 24th of March, 1819.

Preamble.

Monthat provision should be made for the support of a hight-House to be erected upon Point Escuminar, situated at the entrance of Miramichi Bay, for the safety of vessels navigating the waters of the Straits of Northumberland and Gulf of Saint Lawrence; from which such Light-House could be discerned as well as of those coming into and going out of the River Miramichi,

I. Beit enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Coun-

cil, and Assembly, That from and after the time it shall be certified by the Justices of the Peace for the County of Northumberland, in General or Special Sessions, to the Treasurer of the Province, that a Light-House is erected and used as such apon the said Point; there be, and hereby is granted unto His Majesty, his Heirs, and Successors for the support of such Light-House, a duty of two-pence upon every iton each vessel belonging to this Province, of the burthen of fifteen tons and upwards, (other than coasters or fishing vessels) shall measure agreeable to her Register, that may mrive in said River or Harbour; and upon all vessels not belonging to the said Province which shall so arrive, a duty of four-pence upon each and every ton agreeable to the aforesaid measurement; which duties shall be paid at the time of the arrival of such vessels in the said River-or Harbour, sunto the Treasurer of the Province, or his Deputy, who are hereby authorised to demand and receive the same; and upon
