Excellent Majefty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legiflative Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, conflicuted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act paff d in the Parliament of Great-Britain, intituled, " An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year " of His Majefty's Reign, intituled, " An Att for. making more effectual provision. " for the government of the Province of Quebec in North America," and to mak fur. " ther provision for the government of the faid Province ;" and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that it shall and may be lawful for the Juffices of the Peace refiding in each of the Cities of Quebec and Montreal respectively, in their in their Sessions to appoint Night General Quarter Sellions of the Peace, or at any Special Sellion allembled for the Watches and to cause the Cities of purposes of this Act, to be holden in each of the faid Cities respectively, to effabilith. Quebec and Mon-treal to be lighted Night Watches for the respective Cities of Quebec and Montreal, and to cause the faid Cities of Quebcc and Montreal to be lighted by Lamps, as herein-after it isprovided.

Justices of Peace to nominate the Watchmen, with Foreman and Deputy-Foreman and to allow them wages.

II. And be it further enaced by the authority aforefaid, that the faid Juffices of the Peace shall be, and the same are hereby authorized and impowered to nominate and appoint any number of Watchmen in each of the faid Cities of Quebec and Montreal, for the purposes of the present Act, not exceeding twenty-four menin each of the faid Cities of Quebec and Montreal, with a Foreman and Deputy. Foreman to each of the Watches of the faid Cities of Quebec and Montreal, and to allow to each and every of fuch Watchman and Watchman, Foreman and Foremen, Deputy-Foreman and Deputy-Foremen for the faid Cities of Quebec and Montreal respectively, fuch reasonable wages or falary as to the laid Juffices of the Peace, or the majority of them, may appear fair and realonable for their fervices, purfuant to the present Act, out of the fund herein-after provided for the purposes of the present. Act_

Duty of the Foremen to tix Lamps,

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that it shall be the duty of each of the faid Foremen, who shall be fo appointed in virtue of this Act, for each of the laid cities of Quebec and Montreal, or in the absence or illness of either of them, of the Deputy-Foreman in each of the faid cities of Quebec and Montreal, to purchale and provide as early as possible, a sufficient quantity of fuitable Lamps, and them to fix, or caule to be fixed, in the most fuitable and convenient parts of the principal ftreets, public places, lanes and avenues in the respective cities of Quebec and Montreal. Provided always, that in the event of any difficulty or dispute between any tenant or proprietor in either of the faid cities of Quebec and Montreal, and fuch Foreman or Deputy-Foreman, as to the place or manner in which the faid lamps, or any of them, are to be fixed, fuch difficulty or dispute fhall
