### *Governor in Chief.*

**Goods, Stolen.** Bill for the more easy discovery and effectual punishment of buyers and receivers of them, received from the L. C. and read the first time, 194. For the further progress on this Bill, see *Bills sent down by the L. C.*

**Goods, Wares and Merchandize,** account of Duties received on them under the 35th George 3d. see *Appendix*, No. 4.

**Government.** Bill for the better preservation of His Majesty's Government as by Law happily established in the Province of Lower-Canada: read the first time, 34. Passed, 82.

### *Governor in Chief.*

Consents to the House proceeding on divers matters wherein His Majesty's interests are concerned, viz. on the expediency of granting a further sum of money to finish the Gaol at Montreal, 98. On the application from the County of Cornwallis, for an aid to open roads, 166.

Messages from him, by Black Rod, requiring the attendance of the House in the L. C. Chamber, 22, 28, 300. By Privy Counsellors, relating to the Trinity House, 130. *for the proceedings of the House on this Message*, see *Trinity House*, with an Act passed by the Legislature of Upper Canada, 210.

Orders from him to the House, that they make choice of a Speaker, 24.

Proclamations from him, for proroguing, dissolving and convening the Legislature, 6 to 12.

Speaker elect, approved by him, 30.

Speeches from him, at the opening of the Legislature, 34. That part of it relating to Insane persons and Foundlings, taken into consideration, 116. At the prorogation, 302.
