*By His Excellency KER BAILLIE HAMILTON, Esquire,  
Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the  
Island of Newfoundland and its Dependencies.*

**W**HEREAS the General Assembly of this Island stands Prorogued until Wednesday, the Thirtieth day of November instant : And whereas I think fit further to Prorogue the said General Assembly until Tuesday, the Thirty-first day of January next ensuing : I do therefore, by this my Proclamation, further Prorogue the said General Assembly until Tuesday, the Thirty-first day of January next, then to meet for the despatch of business ; and of which all persons concerned are required and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.

Given under my Hand and Seal at the Government House,  
at St. John's, in the aforesaid Island, this Twenty-  
fifth day of November, One Thousand Eight Hun-  
dred and Fifty-three, and in the Seventeenth Year  
of Her Majesty's Reign.
