

PROCLAMATION.

K. B. HAMILTON. (L, S_1) .

* By His Excellency KER BAILLIE HAMILTON, Esquire, Governor and Commander in-Chief in and over the Island of Newfoundland and its Dependencies.

W HEREAS the General Assembly of this Island stands Prorogued until Wednesday, the Thirtieth day of November instant: And whereas I think fit further to Prorogue the said General Assembly until Tuesday, the Thirty-first day of January next ensuing: I do therefore, by this my Proclamation, further Prorogue the said General Assembly until Tuesday, the Thirty-first day of January next, then to meet for the despatch of business; and of which all persons concerned are required and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.
