PIONEER IN MOVEMENT FOR CON-STITUTION PETRUNKEVICH.

Will Be President of the Douma-Public Career Stormy-Born Leader of Men, He Bears the Brunt of Struggle By Constitutional Demecrats-In the Forefront of Russian Liberalism For a Score of Years.

I antly finished his college career at the University of Moscow, he lived for ten years upon his estate, greatly interested in the peasants, studying their life, and habits, and deeds. At the same time he served in the zemstvo of the province and there really began what might be called his public career. His outspoken liberalism aroused hostility among the bureaucrats of St. Petersburg, who early were apprised of his growing influence, and he was dismissed from the zemstvo service, exiled from his native province, and forbidden to live in either of the two capitals. St. Petersburg or Moscow. He then took up his residence in the district of Torjok, and at once became active in the affairs of the zemstvo of the province. It was not long before the zemstvo IVAN PETRUNKEVICE

It was not long before the zemstvo of Tver, under his inspiration, became renowned as the most advanced of all the zemstvos in Russia. But it was not until after the death of Alexander III. that the incident occurred which made Patrunkevich's name resound through. that the incident occurred which made Petrunkevich's name resound throughout the country. Upon the accession of Nicholas II. all the zemstvos sent addresses with felicitations for the young monarch, condelences for the loss of the late Emperor, and best wishes for the late Emperor, and best wishes for a long and prosperous reign. The addresses of the zemstvo of Tver, however, was an extraordinary document. While repeating the felicitations and formulas of the other zemstvos it added that for the welfare of Russia the new monarch should give a constitution to his people, expressing the opinion that only thus could Russia fiourish.

This was the first time that the word
constitution could be said to have been
openly pronounced in Russia, and Petrunkevich with Rodecheff were the authors of it. The Government eventually

It was not until 1904, when Prince Sviatopolk-Mirsky became Minister of the Interior, that Petrunkevich received permission to come to St. Petersburg, and his appearance there was coincident with the meeting of the first zemstvo congress, Nov. 19-22, 1904, of which he unanimously was chosen president. It was this congress twenty-two articles and which started the great movement which finally com-pelled the Emperor to yield to the popular demand for the people to have a share in the Government of the

a share in the Government.

Petrunkevich, whose presence so long had been prohibited in the capital, together with Rodecheff, Prince Serge Troubetskoy, Prince Chakowskoy, and other prominent liberals, most of whom had suffered some penalty for their views in the past, made up the delegation to the congress of 1905.

The Emperor received them at the palace in Peterhof, and, after Prince Troubetskoy had delivered his moving and eloquent speech to the monarch the latter came to Petrunkevich. The Czar evidently had forgotten, or was

He took part in the sittings of the council of Ministers in December, 1905, to discuss the election laws, and in January, 1906, was the chairman of the first national convention of constitutional democrats which met at St. Petersburg, and from that time on he rapidly became known as the most likely candidate for the presidency of the national assembly.

He is regarded as a man of remarkable talent, possessing great personal charm, and, when aroused, a brilliant and effective speaker. As a presiding officer he has been a success in the zematyo congresses, possessing in a high degree that peculiar quality which enables him to quiet the storm when passions are highest.
