WILL OPEN TO PUBLIC NEXT WEEK.

It is a fore-gone conclusion that few people in St. John's to-day know that we have in our midst a local lady possessed of no mean ability, in the production of artistic drawings and oil paintings. The lady referred to is Miss Gertrude Parsons, residing on Forest Road. A visit to this lady's studio at her home, where an excellent display of her work is now being displayed, will convince those who have had the pleasure of viewing work of this kind that the local production can compare favorably with any of the kind seen in the many art galleries abroad. Miss Parsons made a study of oil painting and water color at the Royal Academy, Liverpool, England, twelve years ago, having been a student for two years, under Professor W. Wardlaw Lindsay, who at that time was known the world over as a brilliant artist. He was ex-President of the Liverpool Academy, and ex-President of the Liverpool Society of Paintings and Water Colors at that time. The gifted lady returned home not long before the world war broke out, and sacrificed her profession in doing work for the soldiers. It was not until some twelve months ago that Miss Parsons returned again to her studio, and since then she has turned out a most excellent variety of portraits and landscapes many of which are studies from life. Included in the exhibit on display will be found, dainty little calendars and souvenir Christmas cards, showing many of our local beauties, all having been finished in beautiful water color effect. It is Miss Parsons' intention to open her studio to her friends and the public in general, beginning with Monday of next week, when everyone will be afforded an opportunity of witnessing the splendid exhibits that will be on display.

OBITUARIES OF JUDGE PENNEY.

All that was mortal of the late Judge Penney was laid to rest in the Methodist Cemetery, Carbonear, at 3 o'clock Thursday afternoon. The funeral had been called for after arrival of the train. Unhappily, though due to illness it did not reach Carbonear until nearly 5 o'clock, and having ascertained that it would be so late, the service was changed to three. The funeral was a large, being attended by members from St. John's, Harbour Grace, Hart's Content, Freshwater, other towns and villages. A guard of police led the procession, whilst members of the Masonic Fraternity and their last tribute of respect and affection at the graveside, according to the last honours, under the direction of the R. W. District Deputy, Bro. R. H. and dropped on the casket the words of sacred. Portions of the sacred ritual were read by R. W. Bro. Anderson of Hart's Content and R. W. Bro. Leonard Ash of Carbonear. The service at the residence was presided by the Rev. W. B. Bugden, M.A. The casket was covered with a wreath of floral beauty, a fitting tribute to one to whom God's glorious laws were ever a cause of worship and rejoicing. From the House to the Cemetery gates the Sunday School children were lined up and through the open ranks the cortege passed, led by his brothers-in-law, Captain James Pike and Mr. Robert Simpson. The burial service was conducted by the Rev. W. B. Bugden, Superintendent of the Carbonear Circuit, assisted by the Rev. George Willey.
