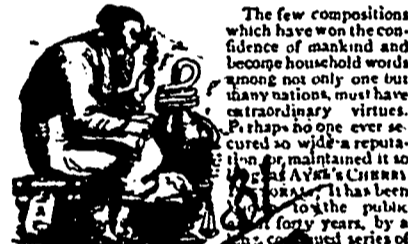

Scientific and Useful. SANITARY QUALITIES OF THE VINE. Prof. Bouchardat attributes to the vine powerful sanitary properties. He asserts that wherever it is cultivated to any considerable extent there is a very sensible diminution of intermittents.

CHICKEN CAKE. Beat the yolks of eight eggs very stiff, add eight ounces of sugar finely powdered and sifted, and eight ounces of sweet almonds, beaten fine or powdered.

SALMON WITH TOMATO SAUCE. Take two slices of salmon, one-quarter of a pound of butter, one-half teaspoonful of chopped parsley; salt, pepper, and grated nutmeg a taste.

RHUBARB JELLY. Sufficient pink rhubarb to make two quarts when cut up quite small, half a pound of loaf sugar, one ounce gelatine, one lemon.

MORE USES FOR CARBOLIC ACID. According to the London "Lancet" the use of carbolic acid has been found specially effective in all that class of local festering, pustulating diseases of the skin which are at once so common and so difficult to cure.
