TARIFF FOR CABS AND CARRIAGES.

Alex. Polson, License Inspector, City Hall; hours 10 to 12.
For conveying one or two passengers from one place to another within the limits of the First Division, with right to return to place of starting within ten minutes—one horse 25c; three or four passengers, 50c. Two horse 50c; every additional passenger 25 cents. Half fare allowed on return if detention exceeds ten minutes; and full fare if detention exceeds 25 mins.
For conveying one or two passengers to or from any place in Second Division to or from any place in First Division—one horse 50 cts; two horse 75 cts. Every additional passenger 25 cts. The same allowance for return passengers as in First Div. The above from 6 a.m. till 10 p.m. After 10 p.m. double rates.
ON TIME.—For every hour completed in conveying one or more passengers, one horse 75c; 2 horse \$1.00. Fractional parts of an hour at same rate. This rate prevails from 6 a.m. till 10 p.m. From 10 p.m. till 6 a.m., \$1.50 for 1 horse, \$2 for 2 horse per hour.
If a passenger wishes to travel from one place to another in second division and finds a cab not under engagement in the division, he can employ it at same rates as apply to first division.
1 or 2 children under 7 free, each additional child half-fare; children over 7 and under 12, half fare; over 12, full fare.
One trunk and hand baggage for each passenger, allowed free.

2ND DIV.—All outside 1st Div. and within City limits. 123a
