SIR:

I have the honor to refer to your Note dated August 14, 1964 together with the attachments thereto, relating to the Agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Canada signed at Washington, D.C. January 22, 1964, on the establishment of the Roosevelt Campobello International Park.

I have the honor to confirm that the necessary implementing legislation, a copy of which is attached,⁽²⁾ was approved in the United States of America July 7, 1964, that the Government of the United States of America agrees with the proposal of the Government of Canada that the Agreement shall come into effect on the 14th day of August, 1964, and that your Note and the attachments thereto, together with this reply and its attachment, shall constitute an agreement between our two governments to that effect.
