Program (1)

The Foreign Government Graduate Awards Program is administered by AUCC on behalf of the Department of External Affairs, in collaboration with the governments of the countries involved. It is designed to provide Canadian graduate students with an opportunity to study abroad during a regular academic year of the receiving country.

Participating countries

Austria, Belgium, China, Colombia, Denmark, Federal Republic of Germany, Finland, France, Egypt, Greece, Hungary, Mexico, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, the Soviet Union, Spain, Switzerland and Yugoslavia.

Application deadline

October 31 of each year

Australia, Ghana, Hong Kong, India, Jamaica, Malta (undergraduate), New Zealand, Nigeria, Sierra Leone, Sri Lanka, Trinidad and Tobago, Uganda and the United Kingdom

Application deadline

October 31 of each year.
December 31 of each year for Australia and New Zealand
