**PROTOCOL AMENDING THE LONG TERM GRAIN AGREEMENT
BETWEEN CANADA AND POLAND**

The Government of Canada and the Government of the Polish People's Republic,

Determined to facilitate and expand trade and commercial relations between their respective countries,

Desirous of amending the Long Term Grain Agreement between the two countries signed at Ottawa on April 19, 1977,

Have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE I

1. The first paragraph of Article I of the Agreement stipulating the overall long term grain agreement quantities as "a minimum of 1.5 million and maximum of 2.4 million metric tons of Canadian grain" shall be amended to read: "a minimum of 1.5 million and a maximum of 3.1 million metric tons of Canadian grain".

2. The second paragraph of Article I of the Agreement stipulating the yearly long term grain agreement quantities as "in each year a minimum of 450,000 and a maximum of 1.0 million metric tons" shall be amended to read: "in each year a minimum of 450,000 and a maximum of 1.5 million metric tons".

ARTICLE II

This Protocol shall enter into force on the date of its signature. It will remain in force for the duration of the Agreement.
