- DA S
- 6.21 Canada should promote the harmonization of environmental protection standards and environmental project assessments, within Canada first and then at the circumpolar level, while taking regional characteristics into account. (Quebec)
- 6.22 The Canadian Government should ensure that decentralization and privatization in circumpolar regions do not take place at the expense of environmental protection.

  (Quebec)
- 6.23 The Canadian Polar Commission should be used to develop Canadian Arctic science policies. (Edmonton)
- 6.24 Canada should place increasing emphasis on international cooperation in scientific and technological matters in its circumpolar foreign policy. In order to fulfill Canada's international obligations however, , increased resources should be allocated for northern monitoring and science which are currently in a state of crisis. (Edmonton, Quebec)
