

The following Bill from the Senate was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House:

Bill S-6, An Act to amend the Canadian Wheat Board Act.—*Mr. Lang.*

The House resumed debate on the motion of Mr. Turner (Ottawa-Carleton), seconded by Mr. Sharp,—That this House approves in general the budgetary policy of the Government.

And on the motion of Mr. Stanfield, seconded by Mr. Wagner, in amendment thereto,—That all the words after "That" be deleted and the following substituted therefor: "this House condemns the Budget as failing to mount a concerted attack on domestic inflation while at the same time proposing measures which contribute to national disunity."

And on the motion of Mr. Nystrom, seconded by Mr. Broadbent, in amendment to the proposed amendment,—That the amendment be amended by changing the period at the end thereof to a semi-colon, and by adding immediately thereafter the following words:

"and for failing to provide any significant tax benefit for low and middle income Canadians while granting unwarranted tax concessions to upper income Canadians and corporations."

At 9.45 o'clock p.m., Mr. Speaker interrupted the debate pursuant to Standing Order 60(6) and the question being put on the proposed amendment to the amendment, it was negatived on the following division:
